While helicopters remain a vital tool for emergency and park management needs, the heavy use of these machines to guide sightseers over the park cannot be justified.

In Glacier, less than one (1) percent of visitors take recreational sightseeing helicopter tours. Yet this one percent drastically impacts the natural soundscape for the remaining 99 percent. Sound familiar?!
